
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



GDP at Current Prices




Total Population of the GCC Countries



Average Daily Oil Production of the GCC Countries




Stock Market Capitalization of the GCC Countries










Contribution of Oil and Non Oil Sectors to GDP




Contribution to Bahrain's GDP by Main Activities, 2016 (%)






Money Supply (M2)








Contribution to Kuwait's GDP by Main Activities, 2016 (%)





Annual Change in CPI (%)






Contribution to Bahrain's GDP by Main Activities, 2016 (%)




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
Annual Change in CPI (%)








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Contribution of Oil and Non Oil Sectors to GDP




Contribution to Bahrain's GDP by Main Activities, 2016 (%)




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Annual Change in CPI (%)




Money Supply (M2)












Contribution to KSA GDP by Main Activities, 2016 (%)



Money Supply (M2)









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
Contribution to UAE's GDP By Main Activities, 2016 (%)
